Grounds Crew / Golf Course

As we transition from spring to summer, both golf courses are progressing well. Soil temperatures are rising, and the recent moisture has fostered healthy growth. I typically use the first half of May to enhance overall plant health on the greens. While this may result in slightly slower green speeds initially, prioritizing their health now will enable us to achieve optimal speeds by Memorial Day.

Over the past eight seasons, we've undertaken significant projects across the course. While larger construction projects remain in the pipeline, my current focus is on refining the details—particularly areas around tees, fairways, and greens. You might notice increased enforcement of traffic control measures in these zones, including stakes, ropes, and permanent barriers like landscape rock. To assist in these efforts, please ensure all four tires of your golf carts remain on the paths near greens and tees.

I would like to extend a heartfelt thank you to all our marshals who volunteer their time. Your support is invaluable and greatly aids my crew.
