Grounds Crew / Golf Course

Both of our golf courses are officially 'put to bed' for the season. We've completed all necessary winterization tasks to ensure the courses are ready for the off-season and well-prepared for next spring. Here's an update on what's been done and what you can expect during winter play:

Course Winterization

- The irrigation system has been successfully blown out to prevent any freezing issues over the winter months.
- All preventative fungicide treatments have been applied to the greens, tees, and fairways, helping protect the course through the colder season.
- For winter play, three cups have been cut per green. To minimize localized wear, we kindly ask golfers to rotate the flagstick clockwise after each hole to help preserve the greens.

Course Conditions and Play Guidelines

- Tee Markers have been removed for the winter, allowing you to tee off from any location on the tee boxes, but please be mindful of turf health when selecting your spot.
- Rakes have been taken off the course for the season, so please foot rake the bunkers as needed to maintain a smooth playing surface for everyone.
- The greens have been top-dressed with sand to help insulate the plant crowns and reduce wear as they rest during the winter months.

We appreciate your cooperation and understanding as we make sure the course remains in great condition through the winter.
